

About Livingston Municipal Airport

The airport is an uncontrolled general aviation airport located on the eastern side of Lake Livingston in Livingston, Texas. The Airport is approximately 6 miles from downtown Livingston on FM 350 South.



Elevation

Livingston Airport is situated on FM 350 South, 6 miles from downtown Livingston and sits at an elevation of 151 feet above sea level. An airport height hazard zoning ordinance was enacted in November 1991. **uncontrolled general aviation airport located on the eastern side of Lake Livingston in Livingston, Texas .**

Runway Access

The airport property accommodates Runway 12/30 with hangar access taxiways and aircraft parking aprons with tiedowns. The airport features 3700 foot by 60 foot of lighted runway. A partial parallel 35 foot in width taxiway is located on the northeasterly side of the north 530 feet of the runway.

Fuel Availability

100LL AVGAS is available on the field with a credit card operated system. The system consists of a 6,000 gallon above ground storage tank and fuel dispenser.

Airport Identifier

The FAA identifier for the Airport is 00R (Zero Zero R). The coordinates are N30.41.15, W95.01.08. The Unicom frequency is 122.7.

Annual Airport Agreement

Per FAA regulations, access to the Airport facilities by aircraft from Lake Livingston Airpark is granted by signing a “through the fence” access agreement with the City and the payment of an annual access fee.
