(Ceilings) 2024 inspection noted prior water staining; moisture meter indicated dry at time of inspection.
(Foundation/Slab(s)) 2024 inspection report noted hairline settlement cracks and cosmetic honeycombing at slab, but stated foundation was functional at time of inspection. No repairs performed.
(Walls/Fences) 2024 inspection noted cosmetic stucco and sheetrock cracks and recommended sealing/caulking.
(Doors) One door not latching properly (media room).
(Interior Walls) 2024 inspection noted cosmetic cracks and nail pops observed in sheetrock.
(Lighting Fixtures) 2024 inspection noted minor electrical items including loose floor outlet and non-functioning patio light. Seller repaired prior to our move-in. No known current issues.
(Electrical Systems) 2024 inspection noted missing expansion fitting at electrical meter.
Also noted loose floor outlet and non-functioning rear patio light, those items were repaired by seller prior to our move-in.
No other known electrical issues.
(Exterior Walls) 2024 inspection noted cosmetic stucco cracks and recommendation for sealing/caulking.
No structural issues reported.



Inspection also noted limited/missing weep screed at base of stucco.
 (Roof) 2024 inspection noted several cracked roof tiles. Seller replaced tiles prior to our move-in. No known current leaks.

(Improper Drainage) 2024 inspection recommended splash blocks/extensions for downspouts and gutter cleaning. Gutters cleaned after move-in, and extensions for downspouts installed.
 (Previous Roof Repairs) In 2024, the previous owner replaced several cracked/damaged roof tiles as identified in a professional inspection report prior to the current owner's purchase. No further roof issues have been observed since.
 (Previous Other Structural Repairs) The previous owner repaired the garage door auto-reverse mechanism prior to move-in.
 (Settling) 2024 inspection noted minor hairline foundation cracks consistent with normal settlement. No structural repairs performed.

"500-year floodplain" means any area of land that: (A) is identified on the flood insurance rate map as a moderate flood hazard area, which is designated on the map as Zone X (shaded); and (B) has a two-tenths of one percent annual chance of flooding, which is considered to be a moderate risk of flooding.

"Flood pool" means the area adjacent to a reservoir that lies above the normal maximum operating level of the reservoir and that is subject to controlled inundation under the management of the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
