

NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING OR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

The real property that you are about to purchase is located in Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 155 and may be subject to district taxes or assessments. The district may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The district may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds.

The current rate of the district property tax is \$0.65 on each \$100 of assessed valuation.

The total amounts of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters and excluding any bonds or any portions of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity, approved by voters are:

\$12,000,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and
\$0 for road facilities; and
\$1,000,000 for parks and recreational facilities.

The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are:

\$11,030,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and
\$0 for road facilities; and
\$970,000 for parks and recreational facilities.

The district is located wholly or partly in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Houston. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved.

The purpose of the district is to provide water, sewer, drainage, flood control, parks and recreational, or other types of facilities and services. The cost of district facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property.

The district may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The district may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. The current rate of the district property tax is \$0.345 on each \$100 of assessed valuation.

The total amount of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding any bonds or any portion of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity, approved by the voters are:

- (i) \$19,500,000, for water, sewer, and drainage facilities;
- (ii) \$0 for road facilities; and
- (iii) \$0 for parks and recreational facilities.

The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are:

- (i) \$17,420,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities.

The district sought and obtained approval of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to adopt and impose a standby fee. The amount of the standby fee is \$-0-. An unpaid standby fee is a personal obligation of the person that owned the property at the time of imposition and is secured by a lien on the property. Any person may request a certificate from the district stating the amount, if any, of unpaid standby fees on a tract of property in the district.
